Welcome to our second Fall Drive-thru Event. The Board of Directors had started planning last year, with hopes to celebrate the 185th Picton Fair, in 2021. This was not to be as COVID 19 continues to influence the best laid plans.

In 2020 the Prince Edward Agricultural Society Board of Directors and volunteers hosted a one day Fall Drive-thru event on October 3rd, "thinking outside the box". What a success! Over 800 vehicles following HPEH Covid 19 Stage 2 guidelines as we stayed in our vehicles and drove around "the race track".

Thank you to everyone that came, making the 2020 event a success. To the County of Prince Edward and their support, our community, volunteers, sponsors, exhibitors. We couldn't have done it without you!

With COVID 19 still in the news, plans are underway to host a 2nd Fall Drive-thru following HPAPH guidelines stage 2, to be held on our regular fair weekend on Saturday, September 11, 2021. **There will be no charge to enter the fairgrounds and participate in the drive-thru. We will be accepting donations again this year to support local initiatives.**

For 2021 we have added a Virtual Competition using AssistExpo. We know it won't be the same as actually bringing your entries to the fair for displaying but we encourage you to participate. All entries have to be **entered into Assist/Expo /Virtual Competition 2021** by no later than September 5, 2021 at midnight. There will no late entries accepted.

You will also note that there is a Virtual Baby Show being offered for 2021. Entries to be entered into AssistExpo/Virtual Competitions 2021/Baby Show. Again we thank Adam Busscher from Picton Home Hardware for being the 2021 Baby Show sponsor.

Nell Casson, Director for the Youth Exhibits has designed a picture, based on the 2020 event, for 2021 Colour Contest. The picture for colouring will be available on our website: pictonfair.ca; Facebook page and in The Picton Gazette.

We will be hosting a Beef Show, August 28 and 29th, 2021 at the cattle barn. We thank the Beef Committee for their planning, in making this event possible to beef breeders, looking for a venue to show and promote their cattle.

Beef Cattle Show

To be subdivided by breed* as follows:

BC - Charolais; BS - Simmental, BO - Other Breeds (including Maine Anjou) **Open Shows will be held Sunday, August 29, 2021 starting at 12:00PM. Breed junior show to start at 10:30am.**

BH - Hereford Open Show; ECOHA Futurity Show and ECOJHA, BA - Angus **Show to be held on Saturday August 28, 2021 starting at 12:00PM. Breed junior show at 10:30am.**

* minimum of 3 Exhibitors and 20 head of cattle required to have own Breed Show.

Rules & Regulations:

1. The Prince Edward Agricultural Society Annual Exhibitor fee of (\$6.00) will be deducted from the exhibitor's prize money.
2. Also refer to the "Rules for Exhibiting" Livestock found on our website: www.pictonfair.ca
3. To ensure we meet COVID 19 Hastings and Prince Edward Public Health guidelines limiting people on the grounds, **spectators are not encouraged.** The beef shows will be live-streamed.
4. Each exhibitor - there will no charge to enter the fairgrounds.
5. A \$10.00 non refundable entry fee to be charged per animal upon registration.
6. Cattle must be on the grounds by 9:00am the day of your show and stay until the end of the show.
7. All cattle entries must bear the "CCIA RFID" tag as per CFIA regulations. **No CCIA tag no entry to fair grounds.**
8. Bedding straw and feed to be provided by exhibitor.
9. Stalling space will be assigned to adhere to COVID regulations and to maximize stall space. If you would like to tie to your trailer or bring your own tie space please let us know so others can be placed where they can.
10. Wash facilities are available but, pressure and hose attachments are limited. If you are able to wash prior to arrival, we encourage you to do so.
11. Registration and screening will begin promptly at 9:00 am with junior showmanship classes beginning at 10:00am sharpe.
12. Registered animals entered for competition must be the bona fide property of a breeding unit. A Breeding Unit is defined as follows: Whether owned by one person or more than one person (individually or jointly) which are maintained on one farm or breeding unit, are considered to be the production of one farm or breeding unit. In all cases where there is any doubt that more than one breeding unit exists, the interpretation shall be that only one breeding unit exists. The responsibility of proof of separation of breeding units shall rest with the exhibitor(s).
13. All cattle must be registered as determined by the by-law of an association authorized to register animals of that breed. The certificate of registration must state that the animal is Purebred or at least 75% of purebred inheritance. Must produce registration papers upon request.
14. Each exhibitor is allowed a maximum of 10 entries excluding the Breeder's Herd.
15. Each exhibitor may show a maximum of 2 entries per section.
16. Classes are subject to change upon number of entries.
17. Calves shown on mature females can register for calf classes.
18. Big Mike's BBQ will be availalbe to purchase food on site.
19. Complimentary coffee, donuts and water will be available.

20. Each exhibitor is responsible for his/her liability insurance. All applicable information is to be reported on the exhibitor form, and may be required to show proof.
21. All Exhibitors are to register their entries online at www.assistexpo.ca/mobile/pictonfair. We will accept entries no later than August 23, 2021 by e-mail pictonfair@hotmail.com or mailed to the Secretary-Treasurer, Prince Edward Agricultural Society, Box 6224, Picton, Ontario K0K 2T0.
