2021 Virtual Fair Competition Rules

Support your Picton Fair by exhibiting in as many Classes and Sections as possible

Exhibits:

1. All 2021 Fair entries are to be entered into the Section "Virtual Competitions 2021" in AssistExpo. There will be no actual entries accepted in 2021 due to COVID 19 restrictions.
2. Virtual Entries are to be entered into AssistExpo no later than September 5th, 2021 at 12:00 midnight.
3. An entry fee is required for all adults 18 years and older to enter exhibits. Exhibitors are to secure an exhibitor's number as assigned by AssistExpo. Previous fair exhibitors will use the same Exhibitor number as in previous years. The entry fee must be prepaid through AssistExpo to secure an exhibitor's number. Entry Fee - \$6.00
4. Unless otherwise noted, exhibitors are restricted to one entry per class.
5. Entries must be those of the exhibitor and not been previously entered, with the exception of the Beef Cattle Shows.
6. Entries are to be of the size, quantity and/or features as described in their class to qualify for prize selection. Unless otherwise noted, entries are to be registered through AssistExpo by September 5, 2021 at 12:00 midnight.

Winnings:

1. Judges decisions are final. No prize will be awarded to an entry deemed to be unworthy.
2. At the discretion of the judges, third prize may be awarded to more than one entry in any Class, when there are a large number of entries in the Class or an exhibit warrants recognition.
3. The Exhibitor winning results will be determined as per the AssistExpo program results.
4. PLEASE NOTE: The Treasurer will no longer retain a membership from your winnings with the exception of Dairy and Beef Sections.
5. Cheques for prize money and slips will be mailed out by October 31 of current year, and we ask that you please cash your cheque by December 31 of current year.
6. Should, for any reason, receipts fall short of expenses and prize in full, the Society reserves the right to uniformly decrease the prizes in order to reduce any such shortfall. The Directors feel that this is a fair and equitable means to distribute and loss and not leave the whole sum as a debt on the Society.

The Society takes reasonable precautions for the security and protection of entries. The Society shall not be liable in any manner for damage, theft, injury, loss or any other claim.

The Society wishes to recognize contribution from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food and Rural Affairs for support received for agricultural exhibiting.
