Support your Picton Fair by exhibiting in as many Classes and Sections as possible

Entries:

1. Exhibitors of **Horses, Beef Cattle, Pets & Poultry is open** to all Prince Edward County and **Non-County residents**.
 2. **All OTHER Sections Exhibitors must have a Prince Edward County, 911 address included on their exhibitor registration form.**
 3. In some classes, exhibitors are specifically restricted to "amateur only". **NOTE: Rule changes for Art Section refer fairbook.**
 3. **AssistExpo link for online entries: www.assistexpo.ca/mobile/pictonfair.**
- An \$6.00 exhibitor fee is required for all adults 18 years and older to enter exhibits. Exhibitors are to secure an exhibitor's number as assigned by AssistExpo when entering entries online and/or obtain from the Fair Office in the Curling Club. Previous fair exhibitors will use the same Exhibitor number as in previous years. The entry fee must be prepaid through AssistExpo or the Fair Office to secure your 2026 exhibitor's number.
4. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to complete the entry form and tags. Tags are to be signed by the exhibitor.
 5. Unless otherwise noted, **exhibitors are restricted to one entry per class.**
 7. Entries must be those of the exhibitor and not been previously entered, with the exception of the Poultry, Horse, Beef Cattle and Dog Shows.
 8. Entries are to be of the size, quantity and/or features as described in their class to qualify for prize selection. Unless otherwise noted, entries are to be registered through AssistExpo by Wednesday, September 9th at 12:00 midnight. Late entries will be accepted at the Fair Office until 8:30pm, Thursday, September 10th.

Note Exception: Livestock Shows (Dairy by midnight September 7, 2026 & Beef by midnight September 7, 2026) and Horse Events to be registered by September 9th at 8:00pm using google registration form.

Placing Entries/Exhibits Shows:

1. Livestock/Cattle to be on the grounds no later than 9 a.m. on the day of showing
2. Entries in the Dog "Mutt" Shows to be at the event location no later than 11:45 a.m.
3. Entries for the Horse Show shall arrive on the premises as necessary for the scheduled programming. *There will be no waiting or changes to accommodate late arrivals.*
4. Baby Show: **its on Saturday**, September 12th,, 2026. Registration: starting at 11:30am. Show: 1:00pm

Exhibits:

1. Entries are to be submitted on Thursday, September 10th, 2026 preceding the Fair between 2:00 and 9:00pm, unless otherwise noted. **There will be no exceptions. Exhibitor tags MUST be affixed to entries when presented on Thursday.**
2. All exhibits are to remain on display until 5 p.m. and picked up no later than 6:30p.m on Sunday, September 12th, 2026. **Early removal can result in forfeit of any winnings.**
3. Entry forms: To be presented for entitlement to exhibit. If inputting on AssistExpo please print off a copy, if unable to print a copy come to the Fair Office, we can print off a copy for you.
4. Placement and removal of exhibits will be completed by Society personnel or under the direction of Society personnel. Exhibitor form to be presented when picking up your entries on Sunday afternoon. **Exhibitors NO LONGER need to return the completed Exhibitor forms to the Fair Office** after the Fair.

Winnings:

1. **Judges decisions are final.** No prize will be awarded to an entry deemed to be unworthy.
2. At the discretion of the judges, third prize may be awarded to more than one entry in any Class, when there are a large number of entries in the Class or an exhibit warrants recognition.
3. The Exhibitor winning results will be determined as per the AssistExpo program results.
4. Cheques for prize money and statements will be mailed out by September 30 of current year, and we ask that you please cash your cheque by December 31, 2025. **NOTE:** All winning for section specials (cash/gift cards/gift certificate) will be mailed out with prize money.
5. Youth prize money under \$50 will receive cash, available for pick-up at the Fair Office Sunday morning, September 13, 2026 at 10:00am.
6. Should, for any reason, receipts fall short of expenses and prize in full, the Society reserves the right to uniformly decrease the prizes in order to reduce any such shortfall. The Directors feel that this is a fair and equitable means to distribute and loss and not leave the whole sum as a debt on the Society.

The Society takes reasonable precautions for the security and protection of entries. The Society shall not be liable in any manner for damage, theft, injury, loss or any other claim.

The Society wishes to recognize contribution from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food and Rural Affairs for support received for agricultural exhibiting.
