Horse Draw to be held Saturday, September 12, 2026.

Will start at 7:00 p.m. in front of the Grandstand

Prize Money, both divisions 1st - \$160 2nd - \$140 3rd - \$120 4th - \$100 5th - \$80

\$60 for hitching - must complete one draw

Trophies - to be announced on Fair Day

Lightweight division - team with combined weight of 3400lbs. or less

Heavyweight division - team with combined weight of 3400lbs. or over

Girths to be measured by a committee official prior to the event

1. A qualifying drive must be a minimum of 15 feet. Knocking down a course marker is a fault disqualifying the draw.
2. Each team will be allowed 2 drawing attempts with a time maximum of three minutes between draws.
3. One driver and two helpers per team will be permitted. However, any interference by helpers will constitute a fault, disqualifying the draw.
4. The same driver (and helpers) may handle more than one team.
5. Slashing with reins or whipping is not allowed.
6. In event of breakage during a drawing attempt, a new draw will be required. Officials will rule on the time the next draw is to be made.
7. Officials and contestants only allowed in the course area during the draw.
8. Any competitor interfering with Judge or Directors will be disqualified. The decision of the Judge is final.
9. An official veterinarian will rule on the eligibility to participate as far as the health of animals is concerned.
10. In case of runaway, where a teamster loses the reins, the team will be disqualified regardless of time during the match.

Rules for exhibiting:

1. All riders, horses and ponies must be under safe control at all times. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and immediate removal from the fairgrounds.
2. Dress Code - proper riding attire and approved helmets are required. Helmets must be worn at all times while mounted.
3. Saddle Horse Show - ponies must not exceed 14.2 hands. Miniature Horse Show entries must be 38 inches or under in height.
4. All riders must carry a minimum of \$2,000,000 liability insurance through Ontario Equestrian Federation (OEF) or another approved insurance carrier when entering the event. A screen shot of copy showing: Name, Year of coverage, Policy number.
5. Lead Line and Walk Trots are classes: Where the riders are not confident to ride at the canter and participants in other classes under saddle.
6. Use of Force: No excessive whipping and spurring. The judge will provide 1 reminder and then may disqualify participants who show poor handling skills. Judge makes final decision on all placings and rules based on AQHA 2026 Rule Book.
7. All adult exhibitors pay entry to Fairgrounds with entries which includes an exhibitor membership & administrative fee of \$10 with registration. The driver of the vehicle gets in the gate free of charge but all adults must pay at the gate if they are not a participant in the show.
